### MARION-GRANT COUNTY SENIOR CENTER

The Marion-Grant County Senior Center focuses on the education, health and financial stability of Grant County Senior citizens, those 50 and older that make up 40% of our population.

We hold quarterly educational programs to protect and enhance our Seniors' quality of life, presentations by professionals explaining the services available to Seniors, library materials, resource guide, special advisors free of charge, up to date opportunities such as computer access and internet usage. Available community services such as transportation and grocery giveaway.

Health programing includes weekly meals, wellness calls, Medicare advisor, social activities such as bingo, euchre, brain aerobics, art, sing along, monthly blood pressure monitoring, annual flu shots, exercise classes, programing on healthy choice in meal planning. Weekly physical clinic with IWU Physical Therapy Doctorate Program, quarterly programing with IWU Occupational Therapy classes.

We offer programing on financial stability including scam prevention and awareness programs, insurance comparison and cost analysis, presentations by professional investors and accountants, ways to protect assets, estate planning, free end of year tax preparation, and free legal aid.
